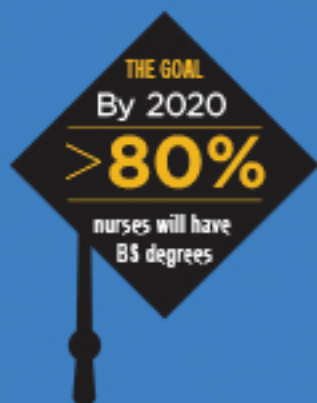




ATB ASSOCIATE TO BACHELOR'S OPTION

The Institute of Medicine has set a goal that by 2020, more than 80 percent of nurses will have bachelor's degrees.
